## How to Schedule Your Testing Appointment

1. You will schedule your testing appointment online at [www.fscj.edu/assessment](http://www.fscj.edu/assessment).

2. Click on this box on the upper right side of the page: 

1. Click on the **register button** and follow the instructions to make your appointment, choosing "Dual Enrollment Testing Program" for your test selection.

2. Bring your referral form, printed appointment page, and school or government-issued ID with you on your test date.

## Information about PERT testing

Individuals may sit for the PERT only twice during their four years of high school. The first testing is without charge. The second sitting fee for all students is \$22.00. Debit and credit cards are accepted anytime; cash is accepted Monday through Thursday until 6 PM. Checks are not accepted.

Picture identification and pencils are required. Students will need to know their social security number.

If the student has any passing scores on the ACT or SAT, please bring a copy of the passing scores to the testing session. Passing scores on the SAT are 440 for verbal and 440 for mathematics. Passing scores on the ACT are 17 for English, 19 for mathematics and 18 for reading. Passing score on the 10<sup>th</sup> grade FCAT is a minimum reading level 4 and math level 5.

All placement testing on campus is administered on computer. Upon completion of the test, the student will receive a score report; the campus will mail the school a score report.
