

## Non-Traditional FAMILY ATHLETICS AGREEMENT

**Our VISION --** To see a community of Christian families and educators providing an excellent spiritual and academic context for educating their students with hands on and creative activities and encouraging each other to reflect the character of God in the world.

**Our Mission --** To be a community of Christian believers who are committed to building strong families, developing moral maturity and achieving academic excellence to prepare God's people for a lifetime of personal ministry.

HCS believes that the precepts of God's word set the absolute standard to which we are to train our children and that the community of families in HCS share common convictions on biblical principles that relate to the moral and academic training of their children. Biblical truth is the foundation of every subject. HCS desires to avoid legalism by remaining committed to God's truth, not our own traditions and ideals.

Our Educational Philosophy -- is founded on the strength of the following primary assumptions:

- There is ultimately no knowledge that is incompatible with the Christian faith, and a sound education is based on the principles of truth given in the Bible.
- Family engagement in the educational process makes a critical difference in the efficacy of a student's education.
- Ethics training, in the context of a reciprocal partnership between teachers and parents, provides the moral foundation necessary for superior scholarship.
- The best learning environment is inquiry-based, promotes critical thinking, fosters a respect for diverse points of view, and is committed to pursuit of truth.
- For Christians, the goal of education is to train students for ministry, regardless of the vocation they choose.

## **General / Handbook**

## **Financial Obligation/Fundraising**

I understand that there is an additional financial obligation associated with being a Non-traditional athlete at Harvest. I agree to pay an annual Non-Traditional registration fee of \$100 per athlete per year. In addition, I understand that I must set up a \$25 FACTS Management account (Billed Annually per family) by the first week of practice and I will use that account to pay the required fees associated with HCS athletics. I also understand that sports fees alone do not cover the cost of sports participation and that I agree to fully participate, willingly and cheerfully, in all fundraising activities. I am required to participate in the fundraisers and either reach the required goals or "buy-out" by making a donation equal to the per family or per child fundraising goal.
